- Concerns were raised about making sure the Limits to Growth APPG is for the benefit of members, making sure that it contributes to work in parliament.
- Research to be done by the Secretariat when designing future meetings on which APPG groups overlap with the interests of the Limits to Growth APPG. It was suggested that such groups should be invited along to meetings and receive any outputs that may be of interest. It was stressed that this is important to avoid any duplication of work.
- Questions were raised about how the group will be funded and that the specific source of money should be transparent.
- It was also stressed that it is important to ensure that parliamentarians attend each of the meetings, rather than having external NGOs dominating events.
